Fly over the S11D Project in drone images

Largest project in Vale's history to be inaugurated on December 17th

On December 17th, Vale will inaugurate the S11D project, the largest project in its history and in the history of the mining industry, in Canaã dos Carajás, Pará state, Brazil. With an investment totaling US\$ 14.3 billion, the S11D comprises a mine and plant with a processing capacity of 90 million tons per year of iron ore, in addition to a logistics structure integrated by a railway spur of 101 kilometers. This branch connects to the Carajás Railroad, which went through an expansion to receive the production of the new mine. The Ponta da Madeira Maritime Terminal, in São Luís, in the state of Maranhão, was also expanded as part of the project.
