

How to ACT in an emergency.

If a hazardous material release occurs at Vale's Port Colborne Refinery, area residents will hear Vale's emergency signal – repeated air horn blasts followed by 5 seconds of silence, be sure to ACT accordingly. Be sure to ACT accordingly.

Always go indoors

Close all doors and windows

Turn off furnace, air conditioners or other air intakes

Do not use the telephone unless you require immediate emergency assistance. Stay tuned to local media for information updates and remain inside until an "all clear message" is broadcast and the air horn has stopped.

Vale tests its air horn, every Friday at 12:30 pm to enhance system maintenance requirements. If you hear the horn at this time, please remember it is simply a regular test of our emergency system.
